If the candidate does not seek ordination after said timeframe, they risk being put on probation and ultimately losing their license.

The candidate for Ordination is asked to prepare a written response to the questions below, a copy of which is to be sent to the District Office in advance of the Ordination Service. The candidate will be asked to give public expression to these at the Ordination Service.

1. Please give testimony of your faith in Jesus Christ, and your spiritual journey.
2. Give expression before this congregation of your call to ministry, as you received it from God.
3. As a Minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, you are enjoined by Scripture to hold to the “sound teaching” that has been entrusted to you (II Timothy 1:13, 14).
You are also enjoined to faithfully “pass on what you have received” (I Corinthians 15:3, 4). Please declare before this congregation and before God your conviction and beliefs on these questions of orthodoxy:
 - (a) God, and who God is.
 - (b) Jesus Christ, His personhood and ministry.
 - (c) The Holy Spirit, His work and office.
 - (d) The Scriptures and its relevance and importance.
 - (e) Mankind, his condition and need.
